Re: Your Response to Labour Council Concerns

Dear Mr. Frizzell,

I thank you for your response and for your offer to sit down for a meeting on this urgent matter.

Before I continue, I will note that since our last communication, I have heard that further escalation from the employer has taken place, including the suspension of shop stewards. Taking action against union representatives like this is deeply troubling, and is not a good indicator that the employer wishes to address this matter in good faith - something I hope is not the case.

Regardless, of intent, the gravity of this situation has required me to bring it to the attention of our Board and affiliates, who together compose 220,000 members across the region. Needless to say, we are all watching this matter with great interest.

Based on your letter, I believe you agree that the best path forward for all parties will be to confront head-on and urgently resolve these issues. To that end, I thank you for agreeing to meet with me. I believe for our conversation to be productive, we must be joined by elected union representatives from UNITE HERE 75. So, I have invited officers President Guled Warsame, and Secretary-Treasurer Shelli Sareen to join us.

My hope is that our meeting will restore a positive dialogue between the employer and UNITE HERE 75, and that we can arrive at some concrete steps to resolves these developing problems and restore good faith, and forge a path toward mutually acceptable resolution.
